1. INTRODUCTION

2. STEPS TO BE FOLLOWED

Step 1: Registration at NMAT by GMAC™: Visit www.nmat.org. to register online and complete the registration process by paying the registration fee. Please remember your NMAT by GMAC™ registration number. The registration number is a prerequisite for completing the NMIMS application.

Step 2: Registration at NMIMS: Visit www.nmims.edu and enter your NMAT by GMAC™ registration number, and complete the application process. You cannot fill out the NMIMS application form without the registration number. Complete the application process by paying the registration fees (as applicable). The registration fee is non-refundable. The NMAT by GMAC™ application scores will be used for further selection processes. For NMIMS admissions, a candidate has to complete the registration at NMIMS only after completing step1. If registration at NMIMS is not completed the applicant will not be considered for NMIMS admission

Registration with NMIMS before your scheduled exam date is mandatory to apply for any NMIMS programs. For example if NMAT by GMAC™ examination is scheduled on 11th October 2025, a candidate must register on or before 10th October 2025.

The candidate has to give the program preference in the NMIMS Registration form . The final program preference will be taken after the shortlisting for further admission process. The candidate must mention minimum five program Preferences in the registration form. After payment a PDF of the application form will be generated on the dashboard.

It is the candidate's responsibility to check this PDF. Preference given by a candidate in the online registration form is for information only. Preference entered after shortlisting will be considered for the merit list and allotment. Candidates are advised to check the data entered in the online registration application form very carefully while registering and again before applying, as they will not be allowed to make any changes after submitting the application.

To be eligible for shortlisting a candidate should have done both the above mentioned steps and appeared for the examination.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION 2026-2028

Finance with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate (all the subjects for which the candidate has taken & appeared). * Sub clauses 3.1 to 3.6 are also applicable for eligibility criteria

4	MBA Pharmaceutical Management ,Mumbai The selection process is separate (Mumbai Campus)	Bachelor's or Master's degree in Pharmacy (B.Pharm / M.Pharm), BDS, BHMS, BAMS, Biochemistry, Biotechnology, MBBS, Microbiology from a recognized University with a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate (all the subjects for which the candidate has taken & appeared). Candidates working in Pharmaceutical Companies or with work experience in the healthcare sector can also apply subject to meeting the above qualification criteria. * Sub clauses 3.1 to 3.6 are also applicable.

Note1: As per University Grants Commission (UGC) notification - F. No. UGC/DEB/2013 dated 14.10.2013 - "Degrees / Diplomas / Certificates awarded for programs conducted by the Open & Distance Learning (ODL) institutions, recognized by Distance Education Council (DEC) (erstwhile) and UGC, in conformity with the UGC Notification on the specification of Degrees should be treated as equivalent to the corresponding awards of the Degree / Diploma / Certificate of the traditional Universities / institutions in the country".

Note 2: The AIU certificate is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their graduation from Overseas Universities.



- 3.1 Candidates appearing for the final examination of their Bachelor's Degree are also eligible to apply for all the full-time programs. Provisional admission is subject to clearing the final examination of their bachelor's Degree with stipulated aggregate marks.
- 3.2 Candidate must have appeared for all his subject(s) / exams before the commencement of the respective Program (s) of NMIMS (Deemed to be University). None of the subjects should be examined after the beginning of the respective course. Also, the candidate should be declared a pass in all the above-referred subjects (s) / examinations by the University from which they are graduating, with minimum stipulated marks in the aggregate. If a candidates' graduating University schedules the final year/semester/trimester examination/s during/after the commencement of the respective Program his candidature may be considered subject to NMIMS (Deemed to be University) discretion.
- 3.3 At the time of admission, a candidate must produce semester-wise / trimester-wise / consolidated (only if University / Institute does not issue individual mark sheets) mark sheets of all college years from which they graduated. Attestation by the Principal with an official seal / self-attestation is mandatory in case internet copies of mark sheets are forwarded.
- 3.4 Candidates, who have passed or have appeared for graduation examination from a University where a grade Point Average is given, must produce the equivalent percentage for the GPA/CGPA obtained in writing from the University concerned.
- 3.5 It is the candidate's sole responsibility to ascertain whether they possess the necessary and requisite qualifications for admission at NMIMS, as verification of the documents is done at the time of final admission only. A professional verification agency will also verify your credentials including work experience. Submission of any fake medical fitness certificate or a mediclaim policy with the wrong pre-existing disease will render your admission ineligible. NMIMS has the full right to disqualify a candidate at any stage of the admission process or afterwards, if found ineligible. In such a case, the candidates admission, even if selected and fees paid, is cancelled and the fees will be refunded as per prescribed refund rules.
- 3.6 Criteria for Valid Work experience
 - Work experience of the candidate after completion of Graduation will be considered & not during period of study.
 - Work experience more than one year will be given weightage in the final merit list
 - Work experience is only deemed valid if the company is listed in both the GSTIN and TAN databases.

Note:

- Training, Internship, apprenticeship will not be considered as valid work experience including working as trainee.
- Candidate work experience gained through Family Business / Self-employment / Executive trainee will not be considered.
- Work Experience wherein salary is paid in cash will not be considered.
- A third party will verify the candidates work experience document, if it is found to be inaccurate or lacking
 at any point, the candidate will be disqualified from the admission process and places out of
 consideration.

4. **SELECTION PROCESS**

Stage 1:NMAT by GMAC™ test is a mandatory for applying to the following NMIMS University programs

1. MBA - Mumbai / Bengaluru / Jadcherla (Hyderabad) / Navi Mumbai / Indore / Ahmedabad 2.MBA HR

Mumbai 3.MBA Business Analytics Mumbai 4. MBA (Digital Transformation) Mumbai 5. MBA Pharmaceutical

The score of the NMAT by GMAC[™] Test for all the NMIMS applicants will be submitted by GMAC to NMIMS (Deemed to-be-University).



Stage 2: Shortlisting based on NMAT sectional and total score will be done only for candidates applying to any of the NMIMS programs..

NMIMS conducts / organizes the 2nd Stage of the selection process for the shortlisted candidates. There could be a competency test, and Personal Interview. The details will be informed subsequently. The selection process is done in person. Please carry your NMAT by GMAC scorecard.

The call letter will be declared on the candidate's dashboard .Call letters will neither be e-mailed nor sent by post.

Weightage will be given to academic performance and work experience also.

- 4.1 The final merit list will be prepared based on marks obtained by a candidate in NMAT by GMAC[™], personal interview, Competency test, work experience and past academic performance.
- 4.2 The selection criteria will be based on merit only. The decision regarding the cut-off of the merit list will solely lie with NMIMS. Candidates who have applied for more than one Programme / Campus in their application forms will be selected based on their merit score and preferences and the availability of the seats in the respective programme. In this regard, the decision of the NMIMS shall be final and binding on all concerned.

- Provisional Degree Certificate/ Passing Certificate (If degree certificate is not available)
- Post Graduate Degree Marksheet, wherever applicable
- Post Graduate Degree Certificate, wherever applicable
- AlU Certificate (University Equivalence) is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their graduation from Overseas Universities
- Migration Certificate
- Eligibility Certificate (if required)
- Work Experience Certificate from their previous employers, the latest salary slip along with TDS certificate from their current employer, and the bank statement showing the deposit of their salary along with Income Tax return documents (if applicable)
- Medical Fitness Certificate (In Original signed & stamp by Registered Medical Practitioner)
- Mediclaim Policy

- 4.3 Original/s documents will be required for verification before program commencement. The original/s documents will be submitted by stipulated dates (if required)
- 4.4 It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to check whether they are eligible for the respective program as per the eligibility criteria for the programs they are applying to
- 4.5 Candidates are advised to visit the NMIMS website, www.nmims.edu, to know the details of the various steps of the selection process. All communication to the candidates will be through the NMIMS website / dashboard only

The Registration fee is non-refundable.
